We now have the opportunity and mitzvah of signing on to HIAS's Welcome to the 118th Congress Campaign, which aims to welcome the new Congress and impress upon them the urgency and importance of ensuring the rights, safety, and dignity of refugees, asylum seekers, humanitarian parolees, and all seeking a haven.

It's easy to get your congregation involved! Please take two simple steps:

Step 1: The first step is to join the HIAS Welcome to Congress Campaign by registering your community [here](#). Join the HIAS Welcome to Congress Campaign. This link refers to delivering signatures and setting up meetings. That will come later, and for now, register your congregation or community organization, which will lead to Step 2.

Step 2: Upon confirmation of your congregation/community's participation p, HIAS will send you a link that you can circulate to collect signatures from the members of your organization or congregation that will be automatically customized for your Congressperson. When HIAS sends you the link, it will be simple to send out to your members and network and simple for them to add their names. In the upcoming weeks, we will be in touch about your letters and meeting requests so we can speak up and stand up together for refugees, asylum seekers, and all immigrants.
